



MicroMedia Filtration, Inc. Commences Operation of Demonstration Facility at Dallas

Lake Forest, April, 18th, 2008 -

The Micro-Media Filtration demonstration facility is now operating in conjunction with the Dallas Water Utility (DWU) and the Texas Commission for Environmental Quality (TCEQ). DWU will conduct sampling and laboratory testing from the facility. The demonstration unit will be running a 24/7 operation under the operational review of DWU.

Sampling will be based both on grab samples as well as 24 hour composite samples. Sampling will occur both on the influent coming into the demonstration facility as well as the final effluent discharged from the facility.

All samples will be tested by the DWU Laboratory for parameters that are being specifically requested by TCEQ. This includes testing for:

- CBOD - mg/L
- BOD₅ - mg/L
- TSS - mg/L
- NTU
- NH₄ - mg/l

The testing will be filtration based since all effluent produced from the facility will be returned to the DWU wastewater plant. No disinfection is being performed on the treated wastewater so coliform testing is not being done.

It is anticipated that the demonstration facility will continue to operate through Spring.
